

# Incident Response to Terrorist Bombings



Incident Response to Terrorist Bombings (IRTB) was developed by the New Mexico Institute of Mining and Technology (New Mexico Tech) and provides first responders with the skills necessary to recognize and report a potential incident involving explosives.

The course provides participants with an understanding of the terrorist threat, information on recognition and capabilities of energetic materials (explosives and incendiaries) that could be used in a terrorist attack, and appropriate response protocols.



Topics covered include but are not limited to:

- Weapons of mass destruction, terrorism and the acquisition of information, materials and tools
- Recognition of energetic materials, devices and device components
- Incident response scenarios
- Response, scene control, safety and evidence collection
